

Kolbarnews Report on the Number of Kolbars Killed and Injured in 1403 “Iranian Calendar”

Kolbari, not an Exception, but a Concrete Manifestation of Structural and Systematic Oppression and Exploitation in Kurdistan. Kolbari is not a temporary anomaly; rather, it is an established rule embedded in the core of the peripheral capitalist system, from which various forms of deprivation and exploitation emerge. This phenomenon is a brutal and explicit representation of the ruthless logic in which Kurdish individuals function not only as cheap labor but also as consumable and expendable bodies within the capitalist profit mechanism.

The oppression of Kolbars cannot be reduced merely to class exploitation, as Kolbari is reproduced within a colonial structure and against a backdrop of national oppression. Like other peripheral regions, Kurdistan has not only been economically underdeveloped but has also faced intensified repressive policies due to its national and identity-based status. In the logic of the Islamic Republic, Kurdistan is not considered an equal part of the political geography; rather, it is defined as a "security issue." As a result, any form of independent economic activity or any attempt to improve people's livelihoods is perceived by security apparatuses not as a social necessity but as a threat.

Under these circumstances, Kolbari being a direct result of economic monopolization and the colonial structure in Kurdistan is not only unrecognized by the government but is also actively criminalized. Kolbars are not just economically exploited; they are also labeled as "security threats" and subjected to state-organized violence. The shooting of Kolbars, landmines planted along their paths, the implementation of severe border security policies, and the arrest and torture of Kolbars all demonstrate how the government simultaneously exploits Kurdish labor while systematically suppressing it. In this sense, Kolbari is not merely an economic outcome of capitalism; it is a stark manifestation of both class and national oppression in Kurdistan. Simply put, Kolbars are laborers forced to sell their lives for a meager wage at the borders between life and death. They do not engage in Kolbari by choice but out of sheer necessity. This reality reflects a structure in which the Kurdish nation is deprived not only of economic rights but also of any form of political self-determination.

This blatant exploitation is rooted in the class structure and economic relations of capitalism, which have turned Kurdistan and Baluchistan into backyard zones for capital accumulation. In this system, Kolbars are the product of a dependent and rent-seeking economy that deprives workers of any social protection, valuing only their physical labor for capital circulation. These laborers, operating within an internal colonial structure, are not only denied the most basic rights but also face daily threats to their lives as a direct consequence of these economic relations. In this context, the Islamic Republic is not only responsible for this situation but actively perpetuates it through its economic, security, and military

policies. The suppression of Kurdish Kolbars is part of the government's broader strategy to control labor forces and reproduce class and national oppression. The killing of Kolbars is not just an isolated act of repression; it is a strategic move to maintain economic monopolies and prevent economic and livelihood independence in Kurdistan.

Kurdistan, as a region that is both severely economically exploited and subjected to continuous political repression, has seen its industrial development deliberately stifled, and all avenues for independent production closed off. At the same time, any alternative means of livelihood outside the government's official framework is labeled as "smuggling" and a "security threat." In such a structure, Kolbari is not an "economic choice" but a forced condition imposed on a subjugated society that must choose between poverty and death.

The following report is not merely an attempt to document the statistics of Kolbars' deaths and repression; rather, it is a testament to the role of complex economic, political, and class structures in creating this inhumane phenomenon. Kolbari is not an individual issue but a socio-historical phenomenon that cannot be resolved without fundamental changes in economic and political structures. To put an end to Kolbari, we must address the roots of these relationships. We must stand against capitalism, class and national oppression, and the ruling system that perpetuates this suffering.

Kurdish Kolbars represent the naked reality of oppression under capitalism. Bodies worn down under the cold mountains, crushed beneath the weight of capital, and suffocated by repressive policies. However, this condition is not inevitable. As history has shown, the oppressed have always been a force of resistance. Thus, this report is not merely a record of repression but also an effort to amplify the voices of nameless laborers who, even in the depths of darkness, continue to resist for liberation.

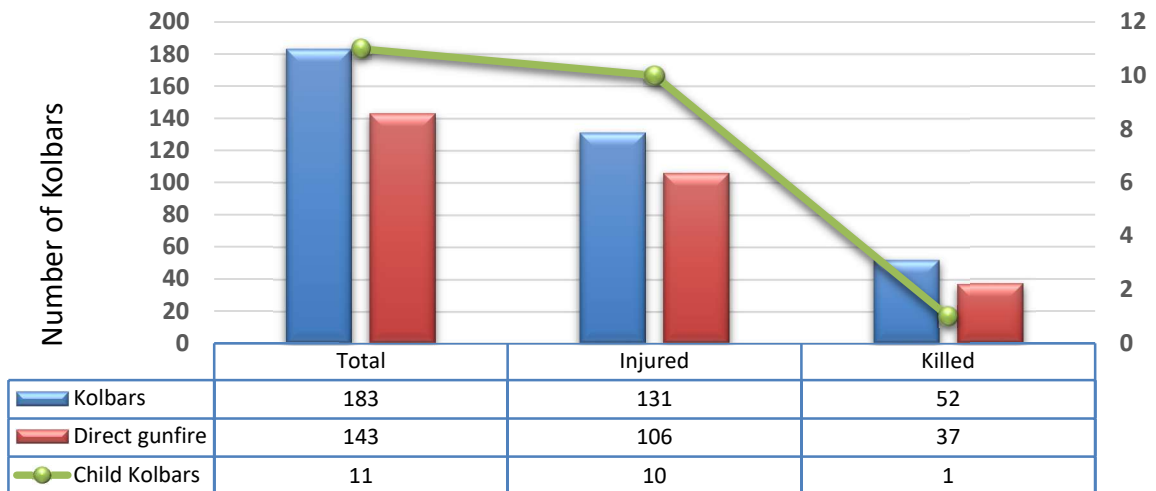

The statistics compiled by Kolbarnews for the year 1403 (Iranian Calendar) are as follows:

According to the recorded data, a total of 183 Kolbars in the border regions and intercity routes of West Azerbaijan, Kurdistan, and Kermanshah provinces have been killed or injured due to various factors, including direct military gunfire, avalanches and frostbite, stepping on landmines, falling from mountains and heights, and other causes.

- ◆ Out of this total, 52 Kolbars (28%) were killed, while 131 Kolbars (72%) were injured.
- ◆ 143 cases (78%) of the total 183 Kolbars killed or injured in 1403 resulted from direct gunfire by regime military forces.
- ◆ 11 Kolbars (6%) of the total 183 cases were child Kolbars under 18 years old, with one case resulting in death due to frostbite.
- ◆ Over the past five years (1399-1403), a total of 1,314 Kolbars have been killed or injured along the Kurdistan border strip. Among them, 1,055 Kolbars (80%) were injured, while 259 Kolbars (20%) lost their lives.

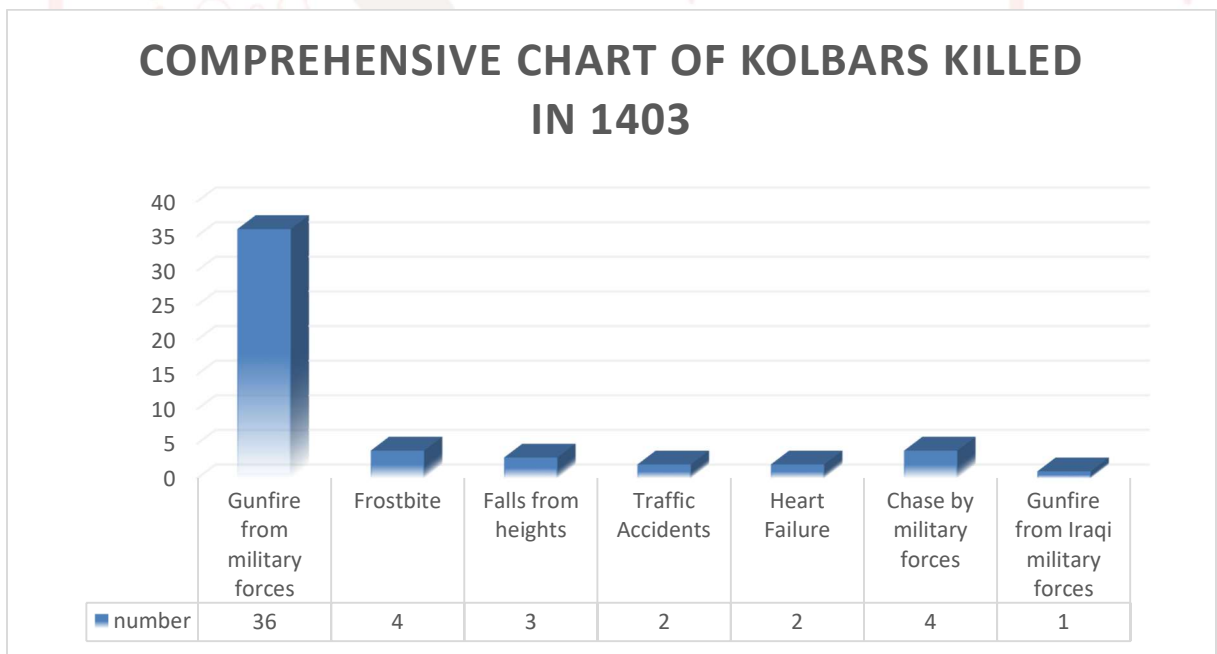
Comprehensive Chart of Kolbari Victims in 1403



Status of the Deceased Kolbars:

Out of the 52 Kolbars who lost their lives in 1403:

- ◆ 36 cases due to direct gunfire by regime military forces
- ◆ 3 cases due to falling from heights while carrying loads
- ◆ 4 cases due to being trapped in blizzards and frostbite
- ◆ 2 cases due to road accidents while traveling to or from Kolbari
- ◆ 4 cases due to vehicle fires caused by pursuit and gunfire from regime forces during travel to or from Kolbari
- ◆ 1 case due to direct gunfire by Iraqi border guards (Haras al-Hudud)
- ◆ 2 cases due to cardiac arrest while carrying loads



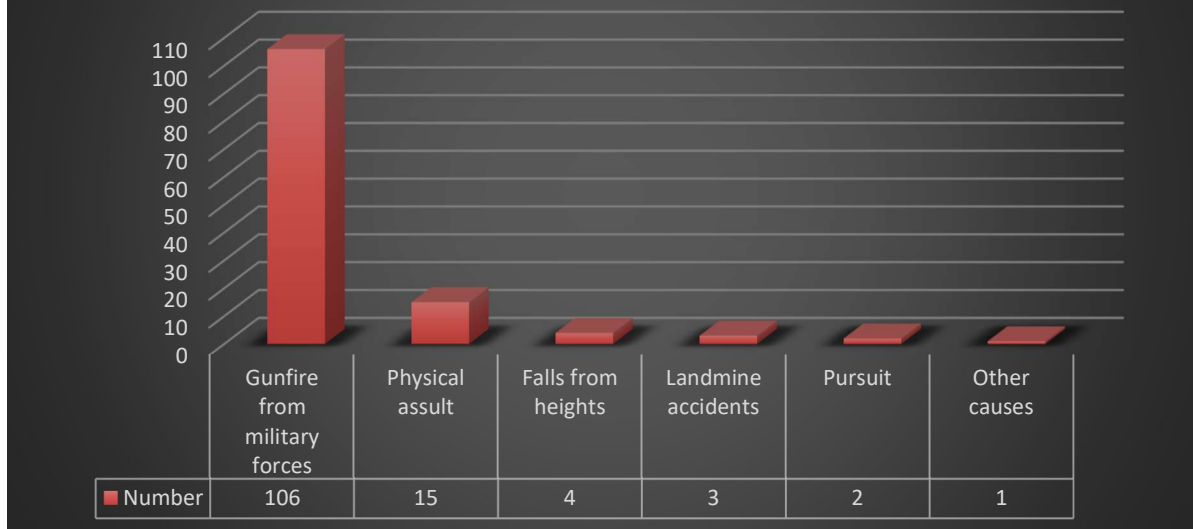
Status of the Injured Kolbars:

Out of the 131 Kolbars who were injured in 1403:

- ◆ 106 cases due to direct gunfire by regime military forces
- ◆ 15 cases due to beating by regime military forces
- ◆ 3 cases due to landmine explosions while carrying loads
- ◆ 4 cases due to falling from heights while carrying loads
- ◆ 2 cases due to pursuit and gunfire by regime military forces
- ◆ 1 case due to tendon rupture in the foot while carrying loads

Comprehensive Chart of Kolbars Injured in 1403

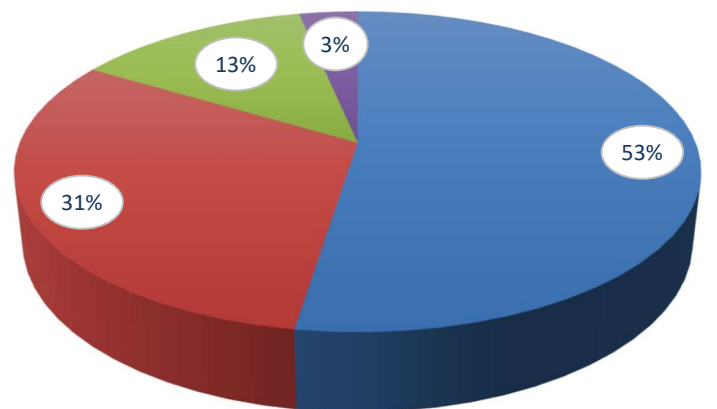


Kolbari Incidents in 1403 by Province:

- ◆ 96 Kolbars (53%) were killed or injured in the border areas and transportation routes of Kurdistan Province.
- ◆ 57 Kolbars (31%) were killed or injured in the border areas and transportation routes of Kermanshah Province.
- ◆ 24 Kolbars (13%) were killed or injured in the border areas and transportation routes of West Azerbaijan Province.
- ◆ 6 Kolbars or traders (3%) were killed or injured in the border areas and transportation routes of other provinces.

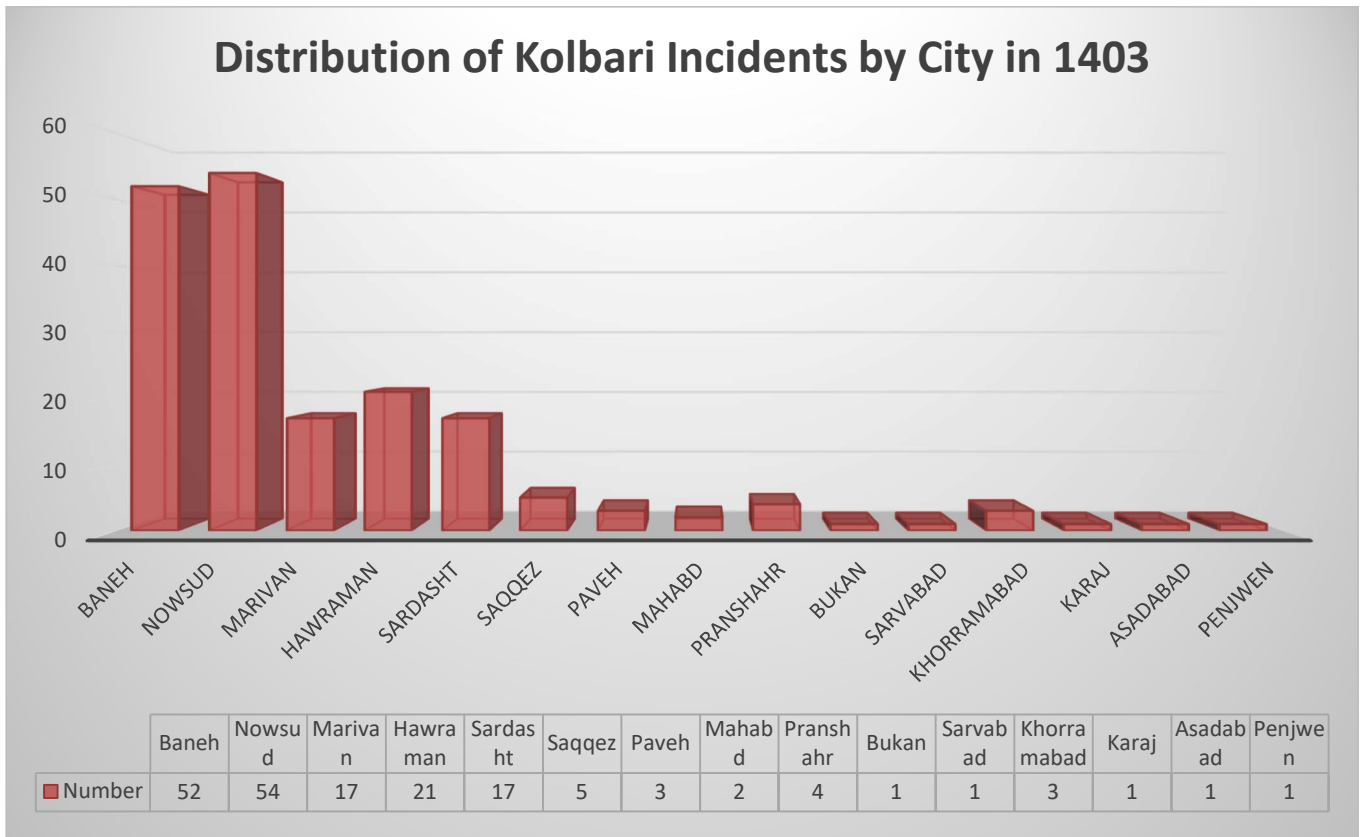
Distribution of Kolbari Incidents by Province in 1403

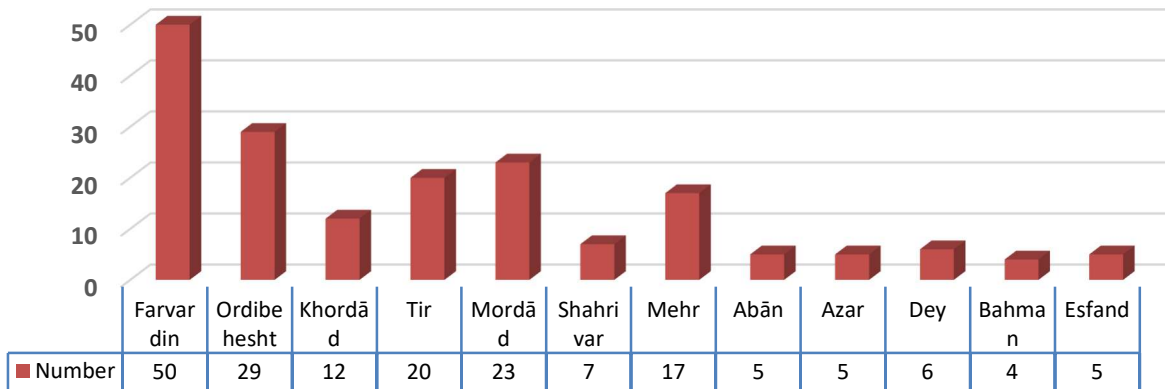
- ◆ In 1403, at least 15 cities in Kurdistan and beyond experienced incidents related to Kolbari.

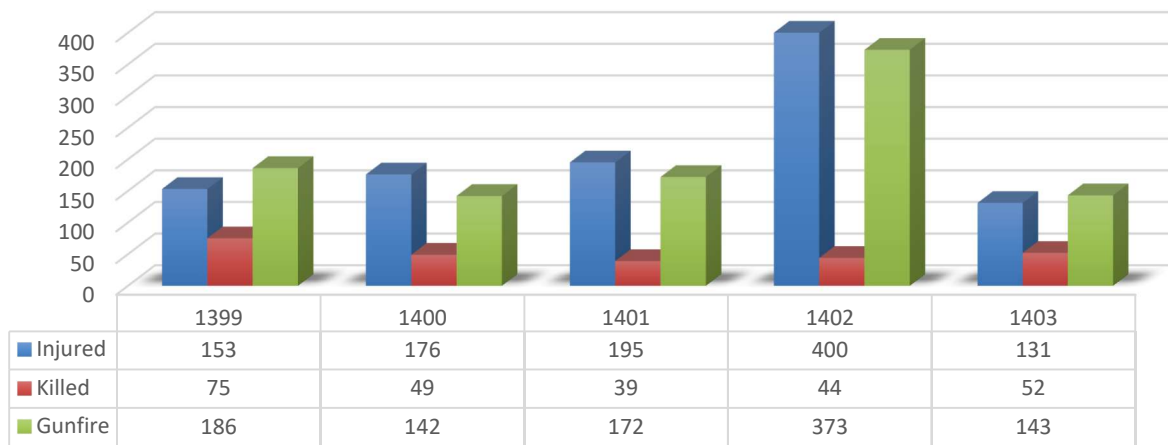
